Discipleship is learning from Jesus how to be like Jesus.

It is the essence of Christianity and therefore not optional for one who calls their self a Christian. Discipleship is learning from Jesus how to be like Jesus.

- It is not enough to say, "Here's what Jesus taught, now do it."
- We must say, "Here's what Jesus taught, here's how he did it, now do it."

Jesus' life was completely characterized by his relationship with the Father.

Attempting to do what Jesus taught apart from a <u>deeply personal</u> and <u>transformative</u> relationship with the Father (how he did it) is futile.

### Solitude is not...

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- Solitude is not to be equated with privacy.
- Solitude is not to be equated with simply 'taking a break from you life' (minivacation by yourself).

Solitude is part of having a <u>deeply personal</u> and <u>transformative</u> relationship with the Father.

It is being alone with God for the purpose of deepening your love for him and others.
